



How to Search for Student Papers

1. Go to the MSFRIC homepage at <http://www.airuniversity.af.mil/MSFRIC/>. Please note that you will be able to search for student papers on our site from any internet connection, however, in order to gain full access, you must connect via a .mil (NIPRNET) computer.
2. Click on **Resources**, then **choose the option for AU Student Papers**.
